Common Spindle (*Euonymus europaeus*)



A species of flowering plant native to much of Europe it is a deciduous shrub or small tree with bright purple berries and attractive autumn colouring.

Guelder Rose (*Viburnum opulus*) "the snowball tree"



A deciduous shrub with large white flowers and bright clusters of juicy red berries in autumn.

Common Dogwood (*Cornus sanguinea*)



A medium to large deciduous shrub with a globose black berry often called "dogberries"

Dog Rose (*Rosa canina*)



A deciduous shrub or wild climbing rose native to Europe its fruits make syrup, tea and marmalade.

English Holly (*Ilex aquifolium*)



An evergreen upright tree or shrub with bright red fruit in October or November.

Cherry Plum (*Prunus cerasifera*)



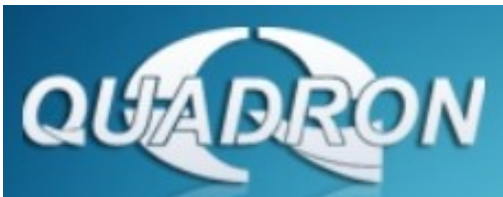
A species of wild plum either as large shrubs or small trees with beautiful fruits for making jam.

Alder Buckthorn (*Rhamnus frangula*) &

Common Buckthorn (*Rhamnus cathartica*)



A tall deciduous shrub which is grown here to attract butterflies together with *Rhamnus cathartica* as they are the only food source for the Brimstone Butterfly (*Gonepteryx rhamni*).
